## TERMS & CONDITIONS OF BOOKING 2005

A deposit of 50% of the total booking fee is required with the completed Booking Form. Cheques, either in sterling or euros, should be made payable to Mr & Mrs P. Sowerby. Confirmation of the booking will be forwarded to you, with details of the date by which the remaining balance must be paid. The balance will be expected 8 weeks prior to the start of your holiday; however, a reminder will be sent to you approximately 10 weeks prior to departure. If the booking is made less than 8 weeks before the commencement of your holiday, then the full amount is payable with the completed Booking Form.

Deposits are non-refundable, and cancellations **MUST BE NOTIFIED IN WRITING**. If the property is re-let for the cancellation period then the deposit may be refunded, less a 10% handling fee, at the discretion of the owners.

The owners will not accept liability for any loss or damage to guests, their belongings or third parties, for loss or damage to motor vehicles or their contents - however caused.

## CONDITIONS OF HIRE

The accommodation is for the number of persons specified and sorry, no pets. The cottages will be available from 4pm at the start of your holiday and must be vacated by 10am on the last morning. You agree to keep the cottage clean and tidy, and leave the property in a similar condition. Breakages and losses must be paid for. Please let us know if any item is damaged or broken so that we can properly prepare the accommodation for our next guests. The rental includes bed linen, towels and tea towels, electricity and heating (wood for log fires in winter). Please note that bookings are from Sunday to Sunday in Wishing Well Cottage & from Saturday to Saturday in both Lavender Studio and Sunflower Lodge. The Garden Suite is available any day of the week.

## USEFUL HINTS
